Safeguarding: Information for students

What is Child safeguarding?

- Protecting young people from harm: physical/verbal/online bullying, sexual abuse, physical attack, being forced to do something you don't want to.

What specifically are we safeguarding you from?

Examples include:

- Abuse: physical, emotional, verbal, online
- Bullying, cyber-bullying
- Self-harm, risky behaviour
- Unsafe activities and environments
- Victimisation due to race, sexuality, faith, gender, disability
- Alcohol and drug misuse
- Eating disorders

If you have a concern, are being harmed or are worried about a friend,

- You can share personal information with the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL), Mr Georgiou OR the Deputy DSL, Dr Polyviou OR your Form Tutor OR Head of Year
- Only those who **need** to know will be informed.

What is the school doing to keep you safe?

- All staff here are trained on how to deal with students at risk
- We have internal systems for dealing with concerns
- We display the designated persons you can speak with
- All staff and visitors authorized to be on the school site are required to wear ID
