- Holistic Review: In addition to the application, the selection process includes a comprehensive review of the student's academic and personal development during Year 1.

Ongoing Requirement: The selected scholar is expected to maintain their position in the top 10% of their cohort each academic year while upholding exemplary conduct, both in and outside the classroom.
