Description:

Coach and Develop Student-Athletes in the English School Sports Programme

Key Responsibilities:

1. Provide High Quality Coaching in all aspects of the specific sport within the English School Sports Programme
2. Implement effective and appropriate training practices to provide both individual and team development in terms of skills, fitness and tactics
3. Develop and implement a comprehensive Coaching Strategy for the specific sport within the parameters of the English School Sports Programme, working closely with the Head of PE
4. Develop and implement an annual training plan for each Year of the Sports Programme
5. Develop and implement Schemes of Work for each year of the Sports Programme
6. Develop curriculum materials relevant to the specific sport to support the development of student-athletes
7. Develop and implement an Assessment Programme for each year of the Sports Programme
8. Manage training areas and training resources effectively, ensuring safe practices in all activities
9. Report any accidents following school policy
10. Liaise with the afternoon coaches of each student-athlete in order to provide the best possible Sports Programme experience for each student-athlete
11. Liaise with the School Team coaches in order to provide the best possible experience for each student-athlete



12. Communicate appropriately with parents to strengthen the School/Home partnership
13. Take all possible steps to encourage student-athletes to develop positive attitudes, a culture of hard work and good sportsmanship
14. Maintain accurate attendance records and follow up on students as necessary
15. Review and evaluate the Sports Programme at regular periods and prepare a written report at the end of the year
16. Contribute to the efficient functioning of the PE Department and perform any other reasonable duties that the Head of PE may require

Minimum qualification requirement:

- Relevant university degree
- Technical Knowledge of the particular Sport across Player/Athlete, Coach and Officials Development
- Excellent command of the English Language
- Experience in coaching teams and individual athletes in the specific sport
- Registered the in Physical Education Teachers Register and have a professional license from the Ministry of Education, Sport and Youth.

Desired qualifications

- The applicant must possess the ability to communicate well.
- Excellent organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills.
- The applicant must possess the ability to relate to students and to teach them on and off the competitive arena.
- The applicant must be willing to accept a high level of accountability.
- The applicant must possess the ability to assess players/athletes effectively
